## About Us

The Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society (SNBWS) is a non-governmental, not political, non profiteering based organization established in the year 2013 by a group of great and dedicated social workers and educationists of tremendous vision as response to the general mass and deprived population. It has been legally registered on 27.12.2013 under the Society Registration Act-XXI of 1860 vide, Regn. No. 1083/2013-14 by the Registrar of Society, Uttar Pradesh Government.

### **The Buddha's Philosophy of Man**

Rahula points out (p.81ff) that the social and economic and even political teachings of the Buddha are less well-known than his philosophy and spirituality. He summarises the teachings of the Cakkavatti Sihanada Sutta (No 26 in the Digha Nikaya of the Pali Canon's Sutta Pitaka) which states that 'poverty is the cause of immorality and crimes such as theft, falsehood, violence, hatred, cruelty etc.'

Rahula also summarises the Kutadanta Sutta of Digha Nikaya which says that trying to suppress crimes through punishment is not the successful method, but says rather that the economic conditions of the people should be improved to eradicate crime.

'The Buddha suggests.... that the economic position of the people should be improved: grain and other facilities for agriculture should be provided for farmers and cultivators; capital should be provided for traders and those engaged in business: adequate wages should be paid to those who are employed. When people are thus provided with opportunities for earning a sufficient income, they will be contented, will have no fear of anxiety, and consequently the country will be peaceful and free from crime. (Rahula, 1959: 81ff).

Children are the future of a nation. For an emerging and developing country like India, development of underprivileged children holds the key to the progress of the nation itself. **ladYi (Sankalp)** is a state level programme of Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society which provides basic education and healthcare to underprivileged children. The ultimate goal of this project is to provide free of cost education of international standard to these destitute children, so that they can eventually extricate themselves from the clutches of poverty. The project will also focus on their emotional and physical development by taking care of issues such as their nutrition, hygiene and health care, so that these kids are able to grow up and make a place for themselves in the world as global citizens.

Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society believes that whether you are addressing healthcare, poverty, population control, unemployment or human rights, there's no better place to start than in the corridors of education.

Education is both the means as well as the end to a better life; means, because it empowers an individual to earn his/her livelihood and the end because it increases one's awareness on a range of issues - from healthcare to appropriate social behavior to understanding one's rights, and in the process evolve as a better citizen.

#### 1. Schools :

Provide quality education to underprivileged children to develop them into confident, employable and responsible citizens of tomorrow.

Provide free quality education to underprivileged children, with a special focus on girl child education, in the rural pockets of India.

Transform students into educated, confident, responsible and self-reliant employable citizens of the country with a deep sense of commitment to their society.

Encourage active involvement of the community, parents and like-minded organizations

Make a lasting and sustainable impact on the community where schools are present, inciting community education

Find innovative solutions, through its primary, elementary and senior secondary schools, to create replicable and scalable components in the program to facilitate delivery of quality education

## 2. Public Library :

One of the primary objectives is to dissuade underprivileged children from begging by giving them an alternative space to spend their day. "The idea is to promote the culture of reading among children. And also for those students who are preparing for competitive examinations and cannot afford to purchase books / reading materials.

## 3. Computer Training Centers

The endeavor is to provide the children understanding of basic functions of the computers and to make them familiar with a few basic computer applications.



**“He who has health has hope; and he who has hope has everything” - Arabic proverb**

India has made rapid strides in the health sector since independence. However, various eye opening data from NFHS clearly indicate that access to healthcare still remains a challenge. While the health statistics of rural India continue to be poor, the health status and access to health services of urban slum dwellers on the other has also surfaced to be equally deplorable. Despite accounting for 1/4th of the country's poor population, urban areas have less than 4% of government primary health care facilities.

संरक्षण (**Sanrakshan**) is one such special initiative of Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society to provide healthcare services to meet the immediate health care needs of the marginalized community in remote rural areas and slums through standalone camps. Customized health camps are organized extensively across the state offering comprehensive health services - curative, preventive, promotive and referral, to a large number of people in selected intervention areas.

1. **Health Care and Rehabilitation Center:** The goal of our is to improve the health status of children and families living on the streets and in slums in Uttar Pradesh. Promoting good medicine practices to community members, who are unfortunate to not have access to daily amenities we take for granted.
2. **Free Medical Camps:** These are small duration camps organised in different parts of the state on the basis of health needs of a specific location. These **health camps** aim at promoting health seeking behaviour in the long term and thus, unlike a general curative health camp, these camps also majorly work on building awareness regarding common ailments, family planning methods, nutrition and hygiene and sanitation. These camps provide comprehensive health services free of any cost. These health camps are organized with support from Hospital, Medical Stores and individual volunteers.



The youth comprises over one-third of the Indian population which in turn constitutes a major part of the labour force of the country. But according to the reports of the Financial Express "Only 15% of the young graduates passing out of colleges are employable; the rest are branded 'unemployable'."

सृजन (Srijan) is state level program of Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society one stop shop for everything Sewing, Knitting and Craft! And it also trains the urban underprivileged adolescent youth in traditional values such as individual creativity, skill development and self-reliance through classroom instruction of many lost arts and crafts of past generations.

One such special initiative of Shanti Nandan Bauddha Welfare Society to provide better quality of life through employment.

#### 1. Art & Crafts Training Center (Including Sewing / Knitting)

We are conducting training course for children and adults on various aspects concerning arts & crafts.

The training program has been designed to provide the newly trained artisans with both backward and forward linkage in terms of providing finance, infrastructure and market support etc., to empower them become independent entrepreneur so that they can start their own enterprise and earn sustainable income. This training program has been designed for duration of 3 months for a batch of 20 artisans to upgrade their skills through comprehensive training in the craft Including Design Development and Technological Up gradation.

#### 2. Art & Crafts Shop / Online Trading

To promote sale of Handicrafts goods. We provide a godown-cum-sales outlet to the artisans as an infrastructural support to augment sales turnover
